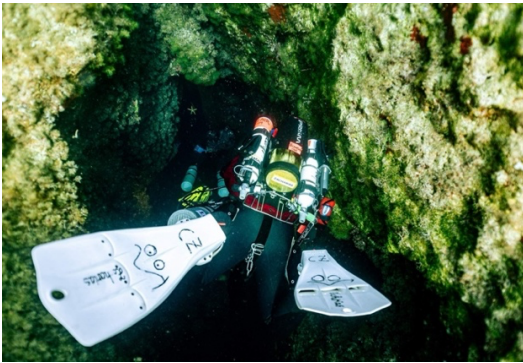


PADI Advance Rebreather Course – Go deeper into the silent world of diving



ABOUT THE REBREATHING COURSE

Through self-study and instructor-guided sessions, you'll learn how rebreathers work and the importance of proper setup and maintenance. Because rebreathers vary significantly, you'll also study the manufacturers' literature for the Hollis PRISM2. During **five dives**, you'll work on many new skills learn more about scrubbers, oxygen consumption and bailout requirements including how to configure a bailout cylinder system.

PROGRAM DURATION

3-4 days covering 1 confined water dive and 4 open water dives (5 total)

PRICE

850 Euro if you have your own PRISM2 rebreather or 950 Euro including the rent of rebreather.

EQUIPMENT AND REBREATHING TO DIVE WITH

We provide a Hollis PRISM2 rebreather with front mounted counter lungs for rent unless you already have purchased one of your own. You'll need **your own mask, fins and exposure suits. Snorkels are optional**, but a collapsible snorkel can be carried in your pocket. You also need a Delayed Surface Marker Buoy (DSMB) and reel/spool.



INTRODUCTION:

A rebreather recycles rather than vents the exhaled breath. The exhaled gas is recycled into a closed loop through a chemical absorbent (scrubber) to remove the carbon dioxide. You get longer no stop limits, and you don't release annoying bubbles. Among others, underwater photographers may prefer to use rebreathers because their quiet operation is less disruptive to marine life. **The PADI Advance Rebreather Diver course takes your rebreather diving to next step to a maximum depth of 30 metres/60 feet and lets you experience.**

PROGRAM PREREQUISITE:

PADI Open Water Diver, PADI Rebreather Diver, have a minimum of 30 logged dives and be at least 18 years old.

CERTIFICATION

After a completed course, and successfully completed the course exam, scoring 80 percent or higher, followed by review of any items missed until achieving mastery, you will be certified as a PADI Rebreather Diver on a Hollis PRISM2 rebreather, and you will receive an E-certificate to prove it
