September – The Best Month to Visit Malta! September is without a doubt the best month to visit Malta—both for divers and those who want to enjoy the island's beauty above the surface.



☀️ **Perfect Climate** – Daytime temperatures range between a pleasant **22–29°C**, with warm and sunny days.

🌊 **Crystal-Clear & Warm Water** – With around **25°C in the sea**, it's the ideal time for diving, snorkeling, or simply taking a refreshing swim.

👤 **Fewer Tourists** – Peak season has passed, meaning **less crowding** at attractions, restaurants, and beaches.

Whether you want to explore the underwater world or soak in Malta's culture and history in a comfortable climate — **September is the month to choose!** 🇲🇹🗣️

Orange Shark Dive Center (orangeshark.eu), offer you a unique Easter adventure from September 6th -13th, 2025. The trip includes five diving days (two dives per day), a total of ten dives, and seven nights in Malta. The arrival day is intended for rest and planning, and the day before departure is a rest day to ensure a safe journey home.

Highlights

- A diving day on Gozo, with two spectacular shore dives at the Inland Sea ([read more](#)) and the Blue Hole ([read more](#)).
- Four shore dives and four boat-based dives on Malta, organized by the dive center's own boat.
- Diving primarily in the mornings, leaving your afternoons and evenings free for sightseeing, shopping, or relaxing in Valletta's charming environment.

⚠️ For those interested, there is also an opportunity to try and dive with rebreathers. Orange Shark Dive Center offers this together with rebreather instructor Claude D Zacharias/Z-DIVE ([read more](#)). For those who don't already know, rebreather diving can also be included as one of the specialty dives in the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver course. ⚠️

Travel

Flights:

Ryanair currently (2025-03-23) offers tickets starting at approximately **SEK 1700 (appr EUR 155) (excluding baggage)**. You are responsible for booking your own flights, but the dive center can assist with transfers to and from the airport. [\[Read more\]](#). Prices and flight times vary according to Ryanair's changes over time.

Transfer Options:

Taxi services and apps like Bolt are available, but these can be more expensive (around **€30–40**). To book a transfer through the dive center, contact Orange Shark (approximately **€15** depending on the number of passengers).

Accommodation

Two hotel options are offered **for two people, including breakfast** in a shared room):

- Room with sea view, offering stunning views of Comino and Gozo.
- Private beach and proximity to the popular dive site Cirkewwa ([read more](#)).
- Half-board available at an additional cost (contact **Orange Shark Dive Center** for details).

- Free cancellation up to 8 days before arrival.

Option 2: (106 € for two persons at Ramla Bay Resort [Hotel Website](#)

- Room (no sea view).
- Private beach and proximity to the popular dive site Cirkewwa ([read more](#)).
- Half-board available at an additional cost (contact **Orange Shark Dive Center** for details).
- Free cancellation up to 8 days before arrival.

Diving and Costs



- Diving Package (10 dives): **€503**
- Two tanks per day (air or Nitrox 32% recommended on four dives for certified divers).
- Weight belt, boat transportation, and shore dives.
- Includes two dives on Gozo.

- Equipment Rental (optional):

- Basic equipment: €70 for 10 dives.
- Dive computer and light: €6 per day (per item).

Non-divers who want to join the boat trips pay only **€15** per boat trip. For equipment rentals, please contact Orange Shark.

⚠ ATTENTION! The water is warm and pleasant this time of year, and a wetsuit is perfectly sufficient. For those who get extra cold, a heated vest is recommended. If anyone is interested in a heated vest, feel free to contact me, and I'll try to help. I personally use **Venture Heat's heated vest**, which works with both wetsuits and drysuits. **⚠**

💰 Practical Information

- **Transportation:** Malta is small, and cars, Bolt, or buses are convenient. Buses cost around €2.50–3 depending on the route.
- **Currency:** Cards are widely accepted, but cash is common for small purchases. ATMs are readily available.
- **Water:** Stay hydrated! Bottled water is a must, especially during diving activities.
- **Travel Adapter:** Malta uses three-pin sockets, so bring a travel adapter.
